





Anointing of the sick: Who receives this sacrament?

The sacrament is Not for those only who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly arrived (SC. 73).

If a sick person who received this anointing recovers his health, he can in the case of another grave illness receive this sacrament again. It is fitting to receive the Anointing of the Sick just prior to a serious operation. The same holds for elderly whose frailty become more pronounced (CCC 1515).


