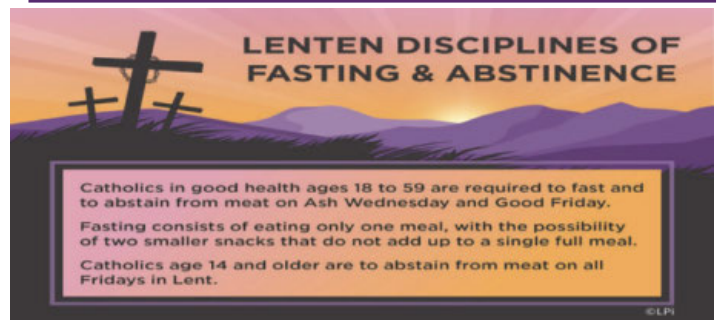

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.

A MESSAGE FROM FR. FRED



Dear Parishioners,

This weekend is that last weekend before we enter into our Lenten journey on February 14th - Ash Wednesday. We finish up Ordinary Time for now with the Gospel of Mark and the story of Jesus' healing a leper. The leper in confidence said to Jesus, "if you wish, you can make me clean." What a powerful statement by one who was labeled unclean and unworthy to be part of the community. We must trust that Jesus wishes all those who feel unclean and unworthy to connect with Him and his healing and forgiveness. It is a good story for us to leap into Lent - to turn to God's healing grace provided through His Son's gift of life. We all desire to be made clean and it is only through our closeness the Lord and his grace that we are truly healed.

This Lent our theme is *Renew and Save us, O Lord*. Together we take time to be marked with ashes and journey to a deeper awareness of God's saving grace in our lives. There will be many traditional Lenten practices this year such as extra Confession times, Friday soup and stations, Bible studies, classes, faith discussion groups and additional hours for Adoration.

In particular, we are inviting you to make a Eucharistic Consecration with the book, *33 Days to Eucharistic Glory*. You can start the journey on different days to end up on special feast days or begin on Ash Wednesday as part of *the Best Lent Ever* - with daily support through Dynamic Catholic ministries. Throughout Lent and Easter the centerfold of our bulletin will be dedicated to our journey together so we can grow in our personal holiness, our relationship with the Lord and others, and find strength to share the good news - Jesus is Risen, He saves us.

I want to bring your attention to the recent statement put out by the Bishops of Arizona regarding the efforts to change to the Arizona State Constitution - "Arizona Abortion Access Act." The Bishops have urged citizens to not sign or endorse the signature campaign to put this on the ballot in November, as its goal is to make it a constitutional right to unrestricted abortion here in Arizona. You can view more information on our webpage. Our Sanctity of Life Ministry is always an excellent parish resource to help us in all the issues that surround the dignity of human life from conception until natural death.

Remember - February 14th is not only Valentine's Day but also Ash Wednesday and the beginning of our Lenten journey. Masses with the distribution of Ashes will be at 9:00am, 12:00 noon and 6:00pm.

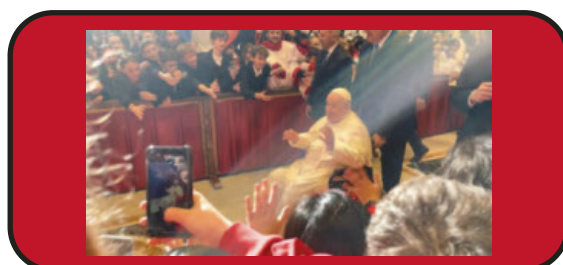

We Sang For The Pope in Rome



Singers from Pueri Cantores St. Bernard of Clairvaux (children's choir) and their families traveled to Rome over Christmas break to participate in the 44th Pueri Cantores International Congress. There we joined over 4000 young singers from around the world to sing at concerts, rehearsals and Masses. The week concluded on January 1, 2024 at St. Peter's Basilica when we attended and sang for Mass (Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary). 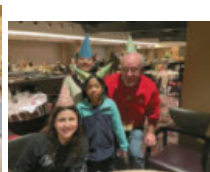


December 31 was a Sunday, meaning that all festival participants would be attending Mass somewhere. So, choirs were grouped together (2 or 3 at a time) and sent into different parishes throughout Rome to sing at a local Mass! Our group was sent to sing for the 11am Mass at "Resurrezione di Nostro Signore" Church on the far east side of Rome, about 45 minutes from the Vatican. We were paired with two French choirs, which was an amazing experience! Even though our group was outnumbered, and Mr. Campbell doesn't speak a lick of French we all communicated effectively and the kids sung beautifully. Two of our

own, Mackenzie and Charlotte even cantored the Responsorial Psalm and Gospel Acclamation in front of the whole church! That evening was New Year's Eve and all the American choirs had a party together! Of course we all needed to be up at about

5:30am the next day to sing at the Papal Mass so we celebrated early and called it a night. Happy New Year!

Important Parish Announcement

St. Bernard's has acquired Two Automated External Defibrillators (AED) for the Church and the Parish Hall

It is not unusual for someone to experience a medical event at Church. This may just be fainting from dehydration, but it could also be something very serious, even life threatening, like a heart attack or a critical heart rhythm condition. One of these heart rhythm conditions is Ventricular Fibrillation (VF) which, if not treated within a few minutes, will cause death. Calling 911 is an important response to a medical emergency, but it likely takes 5 minutes or longer for paramedics to arrive. If the medical problem is VF, that is too long. CPR can help some acute heart events, but it will not fix VF. VF can be treated successfully with a procedure called defibrillation, and an Automated External Defibrillator(AED) is one way to accomplish this. AED's are compact pieces of equipment and have been available since 1999. AED's are found in many public places and are usually mounted on a wall in an easily visible and accessible area. AED's have saved lives. As the name indicates, AED's are automated, meaning that they provide understandable verbal instructions on how to use them and what to do, even for people without formal medical training. Use of an AED can save a life and "buy" time until paramedics arrive.

The availability of an AED is a valuable addition for our Church and provides important, potentially life-saving help for our parishioners and visitors. With the substantial number of group events and meetings, a second AED in the Parish Social Hall is an added measure of safety to that location. Also, encouraging parishioners to take an in-person or online CPR course, would be beneficial and provides more comfort in managing a medical emergency before trained medical personnel arrive.

St. Bernard's will be conducting a CPR class, administered by the City of Scottsdale Fire Department, on Sunday February 25th at 12:30pm in the Parish Hall. Please contact Mary Ann Sarge, 262-510-1573 or the Parish Office, 480-661-9843, to register. We need volunteers to be CPR certified in order to use the AED's, which are very user friendly, and very easy to administer.
