

St. Bernard Mission Team News The mission team will return to


Jamaica for a week in January of 2025. The team will spend a week working with the Missionaries of the Poor in Kingston, Jamaica. We have a very good working

A MESSAGE FROM FR. FRED



Dear Parishioners,

We continue to read from the sixth chapter of John – the Bread of Life discourse. This week Jesus recognizes the physical hunger we have for food and water, but wants us to understand that we have an even deeper hunger and thirst that only God can feed and quench. Ultimately, receiving His Body and Blood is being united to God and becoming one with Him who satisfies all hunger and thirst for meaning, purpose and true peace.

So it is good for us to really think beyond physical hunger and thirst to what it is that we ultimately hunger and thirst for? Some in the world want success, money, power, safety and security. They strive for it with all they have and are left in frustration trying to

create a utopia or perfect world. When we hunger for true peace, love and joy – we find God. The world does not look different, there remains good and bad, joys and sorrows, but the way we live as Christians is different. We are confident in the Lord and trust that He feeds our deepest hungers and thirsts. Ponder this week how we are fed in the Eucharist – the very real gift of God's Son, His Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. The Eucharist contains the very essence of all Jesus is – His love, mercy, justice, forgiveness, compassion and strength. In Him we can endure all things. We find true peace and our deepest desires are satiated. For we have the very Bread of Life.

Learn – Grow – Be Formed is our new call as a parish to learn more about Jesus and the Church, our Catholic faith. As disciples, we are called to learn, soak in God's words and ways in order to live as true missionaries. This means we strive continually to form our minds and hearts. We can do so in many ways through classes, books, study groups, etc. We are blessed to now be part of the Augustine Institute's FORMED subscription service. There is more information in our bulletin centerfold on how to enroll and access thousands of videos for you and your family to grow. Each week, we will promote a video for us to watch as a community. Please take time to watch it and then talk about it with your family and friends. What surprised you? What did you learn? How did it move you to deeper charity/love for your family, neighbor, and community?

Formation is an ongoing journey. We continue to grow but only if we feed ourselves with good food – starting always with Eucharist but also with God's Word and the teachings of the Church. It is a blessing to be on a journey together. One where we strive to grow in holiness and love for the Lord and one another. We are called to a deeper relationship with Him and with the people He places in our lives.

May the Holy Spirit enkindle in us a renewed sense of our hunger and thirst for God's abundant love as we are fed in the Eucharist here at Saint Bernard of Clairvaux. Commit to being a missionary disciple and share that abundant love with a friend or coworker this week.

Elementary Faith Formation News K-8th Grade

Registration for Faith Formation for all Kindergarten through Eighth Grade students will be held after all masses the week end of August 10th/11th and August 17th/18th. You may also register in the parish office after August 12th.

We are excited to introduce a new series this year. The parish will be teaming up with "Formed" from Augustine Institute and their "Word of Life" series. This is an interactive program and through your free access to "Formed", as a registered parishioner, you will be able to work with the catechists in forming your children's faith and preparing them to receive their sacraments. "Formed" will offer many Adult Formation opportunities, too!

All Elementary classes, Kindergarten through the Eighth Grade, will be offered on Tuesday's or Thursday's after school and early evening. Classes will begin the week of September 9th.

The parish is the preeminent place for the catechesis of adults, youth and children. We are here to assist parents who are the primary educators in the faith for their children. Formal catechesis at St. Bernard's begins in Kindergarten. In this diocese, preparation for the Sacrament of First Reconciliation takes place in Second Grade and Confirmation and First Eucharist in Third Grade. All children beyond the third grade, who are in need of Confirmation, should enroll in their grade level class for preparation.

Our "Heritage" classes are for children, Third through Eighth Grade, baptized or unbaptized, who have missed preparing for the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist at the younger ages. We also offer Liturgy of the Word at the 9am Mass on Sunday. There is no registration for this.

It is important to remember that I cannot do this alone, so I am asking parishioners of all ages to please pray about becoming a catechist. All training and materials will be provided for you and there are many grade levels to choose from. Please call me at 480-661-9843 ext. 314 or email me at kstine@stboc.org if you are interested in sharing faith with God's children or for more information on all of our programs.




