

#### A MESSAGE FROM FR. FRED



#### Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate Labor Day, a national holiday, recognizing the dignity of human labor. The Church has always supported the inherent dignity to work and to provide for daily living. Labor Day for the Church worldwide is the Feast of Saint Joseph the Worker on May 1st. It is the "World Labor Day" and Pope Francis wrote the following on the Feast in 2013, "Work is fundamental to the dignity of a person. Work, to use an image, anoints us with dignity, fills us with dignity, makes us similar to God, who has worked and still works, who always acts..." This Labor Day let us give thanks to God for those who labor in factories, fields and various

professions that help to foster a healthy society that values the dignity of human labor and the gift of the individuals laborer.

We return to the Gospel of Mark this week and are reminded of the vital condition or state of our heart in the life of holiness. We can sometimes get caught up in all that is going on outside and in other people's lives and totally miss the coldness or hardness that has seeped into our own hearts. Jesus warns about being hypocrites and making human traditions and practices equal to God's laws that were given to Moses and fulfilled in Jesus and the Beatitudes. #### **Elementary Faith Formation News K-8th Grade**

Registration for Faith Formation for all Kindergarten through Eighth Grade students is going well and classes are filling up quickly. You may now register in the parish office.

All Elementary classes, Kindergarten through the Eighth Grade, will be offered on Tuesday's or Thursday's after school and early evening. Classes will begin the week of September 9th.

Formal catechesis at St. Bernard's begins in Kindergarten. In this diocese preparation for the Sacrament of First Reconciliation takes place in Second Grade and Confirmation and First Eucharist in Third Grade. All children beyond the third grade who are in need of Confirmation should enroll in their grade level class for preparation.

Our "Heritage" classes are for children, Third through Eighth Grade, baptized or unbaptized, who have missed preparing for the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation and Eucharist at the younger ages. We also offer Liturgy of the Word at the 9am Mass on Sunday. There is no registration for this.


