The Following news and topics were presented by Fr. Mike

- Fr. Mike has moved the majority of his belongings to his new residence in Phoenix. He finds it's about a 45 minute commute to St. Bernard's. He is making some adjustments to his schedule avoid commuting during peak traffic hours.
- Fr. Mike noted that Fr. Simon is off for a month starting the first weekend after Easter. June 4-18 Fr. Simon will be in Rome with the Padre Pio prayer group. Fr. Chuck cannot fill in during Fr. Simon's absence. Fr. Fred is on sabbatical. Fr. Fred may show up in town a few days in May. Fr. Mike will be here and is hopeful he will have some support.
- There will be no council meeting in April; no council meeting in June. The next meeting is May 8, 2023.
- Parishioners offered a house for Fr. Fred and Fr. Simon to lease. They are proceeding with their plans to move into the house together.
- The Capital Campaign for the Rectory starts up again next weekend (March 25, 26) with Fr. Mike speaking about the rectory after all masses. Barry informed the members that new brochures will be passed out after masses this weekend in conjunction with Fr. Mike's talk after each mass.

Building and Fundraising Update:

• There are no more updates at this time regarding the rectory. Michael reported that we have not heard back from the city regarding the finalization questions we need answered.
