



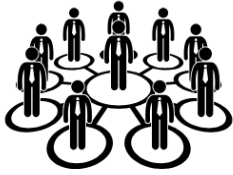

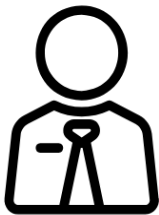

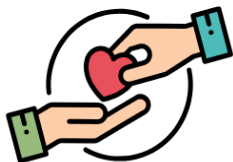

A Parish Alive in God's Grace

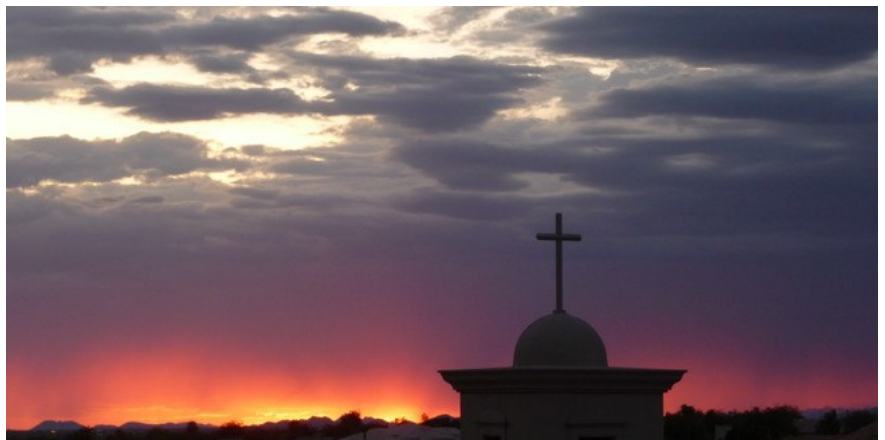

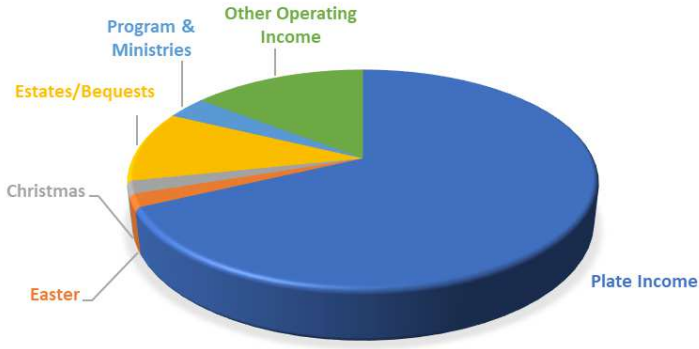

OPERATING INCOME - FYE 2025



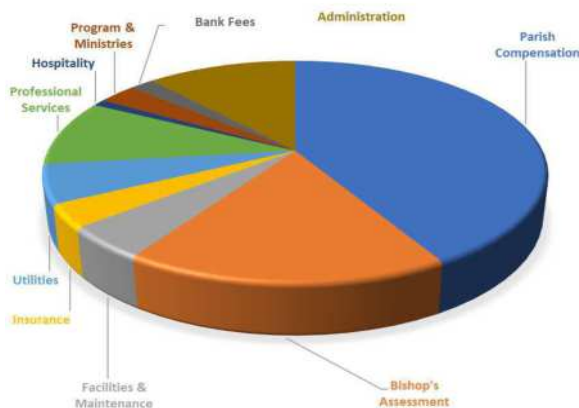

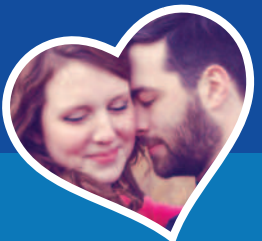
